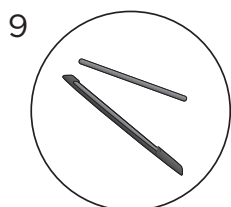
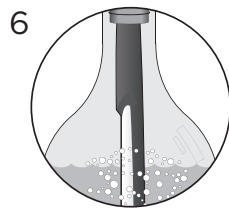
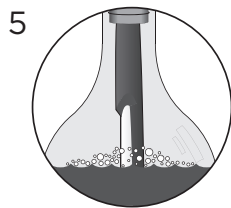
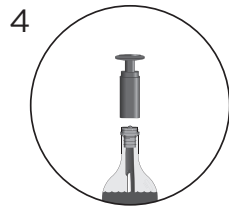
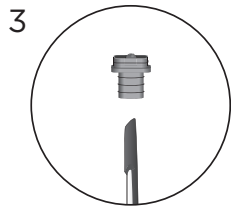
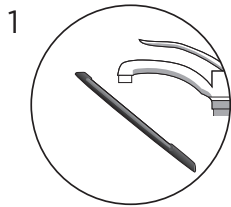


## THANK YOU FOR PURCHASING VINOVINTI

For best results, please read the instructions carefully before use.



1. Rinse the rod and holder before using for the first time.

2. Open the bottle and pour 1 - 2 ounces of wine into a glass. This makes room for the rod and holder and allows for a taste comparison.

3. Insert longer end of the holder into the stopper. Lower the assembly into the bottle and push the stopper into the bottle firmly.

4. Place the vacuum pump securely on top of the stopper to create a seal. Hold it firmly in place and pump by pulling handle up and down until you see bubbles. Then stop.

5. In red wines, bubbles can be difficult to see. Watch closely at the surface of the wine.

6. In white wines, bubbles are easily seen rising through the wine.

7. Wait 20-30 seconds, release the vacuum (pull the nub on top of the stopper) and remove the pump.

8. Remove stopper, rod and holder from the bottle. Taste the wine. Step 4 can be repeated. Please note that too much pumping can leave wine tasting flat.

9. When finished, remove the rod from holder and rinse thoroughly with water. **IMPORTANT:** The ceramic rod must be completely dry before storing. Store in a cool, dry location.

10. Enjoy.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Wines have different levels of CO<sub>2</sub>. Optimal extraction times will vary.
- Excessive pumping will leave wine tasting flat.
- Rod does not have to be dry to use. It must be completely dry before storing.
- Red wine will tint rod. This does not reduce effectiveness.
- Not intended for use with sparkling wines.
